Page 141, last paragraph:

The approach, via the use of insulating sheathing, allows the construction of assemblies that are vapor open to the interior in all climate zones. Interior vapor resistance, beyond that of latex painted gypsum board is not required if sufficient thermal resistance is provided by insulating sheathing.

Page 381, last paragraph:

Insect control and groundwater control principles developed for rigid exterior foam insulations used in below grade applications or ground contact applications should be used.

Page 50, first paragraph:

There is information relating to air leakage testing of building enclosure leakage areas, testing of the leakage of duct systems, air pressure differentials and combustion safety in Appendix II.
